## Create your own program length

The contents could be used as separate series or together with the Introduction and Documentary. All in all we provide about 30 minutes filmed material from each place.

### THE DIFFERENT FILM PARTS:

From each city / area we provide:

- **Introduction part, 5 minutes, (Acerca de...)**

A five-minute narrated introduction to the area and city.

This part could be watched and used as a stand-alone part.

- **Documentary part, 10 minutes**

A ten-minute documentary program introduced by a young presenter, our Host, featuring his or her exciting life, friends and families in different environments.

*These two main parts above can be edited together and create a 15 minutes program.*

- **¡Buen provecho!, 5 minutes**

In the series with 5 minutes food programs, each Host is preparing a favorite dish and tells us about typical food from the area.

- **Una historia - A Story, 1-2 minutes**

They all tell a short story or an anecdote.

- **17 preguntas -17 questions, 3-6 minutes**

All our Hosts answer the same personal questions. Do they answer the same? What are their dreams and plans? What are their values in life? Get to know our presenters even better!

- **Verdadero o Falso - True or False?, 2-3 minutes**

The viewer has to guess if 10 statements given by our protagonists are correct or not.

- **La Postal - The video postcards, less than 1 minute**

In short presentations, video Postcards, our main persons send an appetizer and a short presentation to its prospective audience.

#### TARGET GROUP:

Teenagers and adults. From language level A2-B1.

Thanks to its substantial contents it will also satisfy the needs of more advanced students. They will certainly appreciate discussing the wide range of topics presented. By using subtitles the contents and visuals will be interesting also for real beginners.

#### LANGUAGE:

All language contents in Spanish.

Introduction parts: Language scripted.

Documentaries: Language not scripted but controlled, following a detailed outline. Supplementary parts as described above: Spontaneous language.

#### EXTRA MATERIAL / OPTIONS:

In addition we provide photos, subtitled versions (in Spanish) and Service material / Teacher's guide which includes the texts/dialogues, word lists, three levels of exercises, background information & facts.

#### TECHNICAL FACTS:

The film files are available in a variety of different formats: for the web / internet, dvd, broadcast etc. The material is filmed in full HD, on location.

#### FORMAT:

The same program format and concept is also available in English (World Wide English), French (Francophonie !) and German (Deutsch Europaweit), all series newly produced.

## Batallones Femeninos - Juarez, Mexico

*Hip Hop Female Activist Collective*

*Themes: Ciudad Juárez as a border town – social/political themes – Rap music – creativity – friendship – drug issues – violence against women – power of youth movements*

*“We express what a lot of people want to say and some don’t want to hear”*

Cuidad Juarez is one of the most violent cities of the world. Center of the drug war for many years, young people have nearly no chances as working in drugs or working in the sewing factories.

A lot of women disappeared in the last years. Batallones Femeninos started in 2009 in a city where violence makes you stay at home and hide under your bed. We meet Dilema, Dilema, Murder and Oveja Negra.

This group tries to represent the feelings and thoughts of the women at Mexico’s border with the United States. They paint (graffiti), sing their Rap songs and dance. The lyrics from what they sing are very poetic and powerful. They are all in a fight for survival every day, but they try to overcome all of this with their creativity and their power and intelligence.



## Patricio in Buenos Aires, Argentina

*Industrial Design Student, art and music*

*Themes: discovering Buenos Aires barrio life – new in town – studying at the university, living with his sister – creativity: theatre/rap music entrepreneur – a glimpse back home in Jujuy and its beautiful nature.*

*“My passion is to look at the wonderful details of life”*

Patricio's family is from Jujuy, the north of Argentina, a beautiful town in the Andes mountains. Even though he moved to Buenos Aires for his studies, nature is one of the things that inspire him the most. For this reason he loves the Botanic Garden near his house. Patricio lives with his cat and his older sister in the house his grandparents used to live in.

Patricio likes designing and making his own things. This is the reason to study industrial design. At his young age, he is already creating his own business to sell them.
